A NEW SEASON IN OUR CHILDREN'S OUTREACH

After such a long break we now have an opportunity to do a new thing as we plan to return to our Children's outreach. We have had time to stop, take stock and look at what needs to be laid down and what needs to be changed. Our plan is to have **one** children's activity per week (term-time only) and focus on making that one activity the best it can be. We plan to run a group on Wednesday evenings 3.30 - 5pm. Instead of picking the children up at school we will ask parents to drop children off, which means that parents can stop for a coffee and chat should they wish. The group will be using elements of both Godly Play and Messy Church for 20 children ranging from 7 to 10 years old. The structure will start with snacks, moving into room 2 for a Godly Play Bible story and then back into the hall where there will be themed activities, including baking and some sport/games. Each session will end with quiet time, where we share the day's baking and have a short time of prayer, as well as taking prayer requests for Sunday's service. However, we need volunteers! This could be in the kitchen doing the snacks or it could be running an activity or baking with a small group. You don't have to come every week - we are hoping to have a rota so that nobody is stretched too much. Please prayerfully consider whether God is calling you to support our youth outreach in this way and if He is - please get back to me. Blessings Helen
