COMMUNITY GARDEN PROJECT

You will see that the trees in the graveyard are now looking very smart and later this month we will be receiving two large planters from Rawdon in Bloom to live outside the church - a big thanks to them for organising this and for offering to plant the 250 whips which will arrive in March to provide a safe and natural wild hedge between the graveyard and the Genesis Labels carpark.

In January, the area around the graves will be cleared and ivy removed from the wall. Raised beds will be put in and the two remaining graves laid down due to possible danger.
